

Dubuque Arts Council 2011-2012 Scholarship Guidelines and Application

Eligibility

Eligible students are residents of a county in which the Dubuque Arts Council serves (Dubuque, Jo Daviess, Jackson, Grant counties) and are enrolled at a college or university within the same counties. These schools include Clarke University, Loras College, University of Dubuque, Divine Word College and Emmaus Bible College in Dubuque county; University of Wisconsin-Platteville in Grant county. Eligible students have declared a major or minor within the area of visual or performing arts.

Scholarship

Two scholarships are available for the 2011-2012 school year in the amount of \$1,000 each. Payment will be made directly to the institution.

Deadline

Completed applications must be received at the Dubuque Arts Council office by 5:00 p.m. on March 31, 2011.

To Apply

Complete the attached application form and send it to the Dubuque Arts Council along with two letters of recommendation and a typed statement of up to 500 words highlighting why you are majoring or minoring in the arts and why you are the best choice to receive this scholarship.
